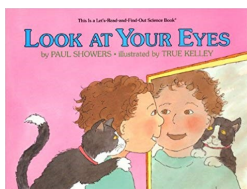
Schuh, M. At the Dentist. Simple text, photographs, and diagrams present information about going to the dentist and how to take care of teeth properly .

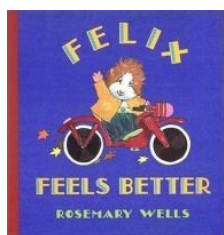
