First Download and setup Adobe Digital Editions

1. Download and install Adobe digital editions from:

Adobe Digital Editions 4.5.11 Installers

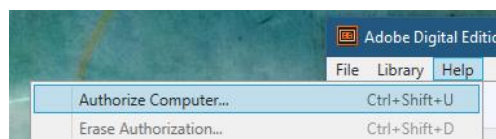


3. Adobe Digital Editions should open after it is installed, if not open it.

- a. Click: **“Help”**
- b. Click **“Authorize Computer**



c. Enter Adobe ID,

*If you don't already have an Adobe ID, Click: **"Create an Adobe ID"**

d. Log in with your Adobe ID

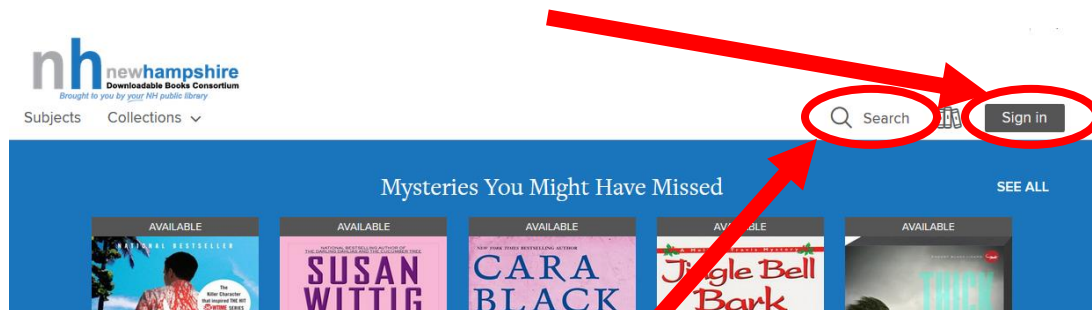
e. Click: **"Authorize"**

*Now that this is set up you can now move on to the next section, detailing how to download an e-book to your Nook device.

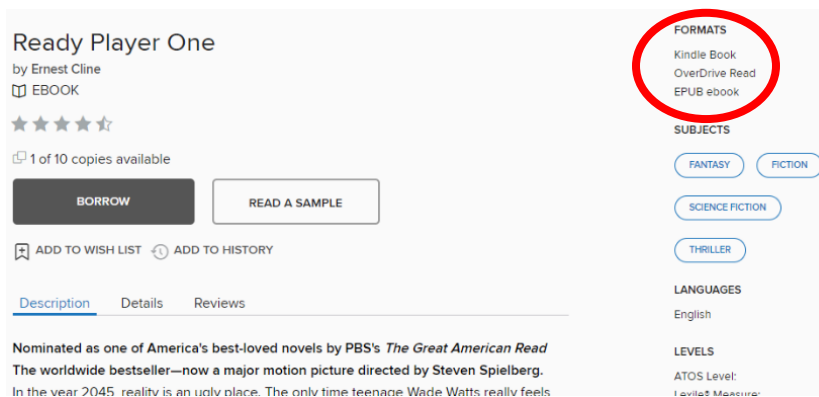



How to Download an E-book.

1. Go to nh.overdrive.com on your computer.
2. Sign in (upper right of screen) with library card number and PIN (set this up through RPL's website)



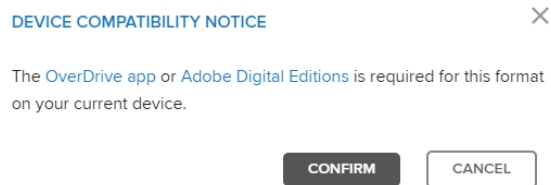
3. Find a title by searching in box at top right or by browsing the lists of subjects or collections on the left.
4. Click the book cover to learn more about a book.
5. Check Formats on the right of the screen to make sure your device is compatible. You will need to download an EPUB ebook



10. To borrow a book
 - a. Click the book's cover image
 - b. Click: "**Borrow**" 
 - c. Choose if you would like to borrow for 7 days or 14 days.



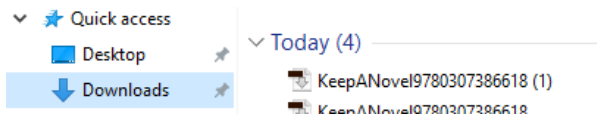
d. A device compatibility notice will pop up.



e. Click **“Confirm”**

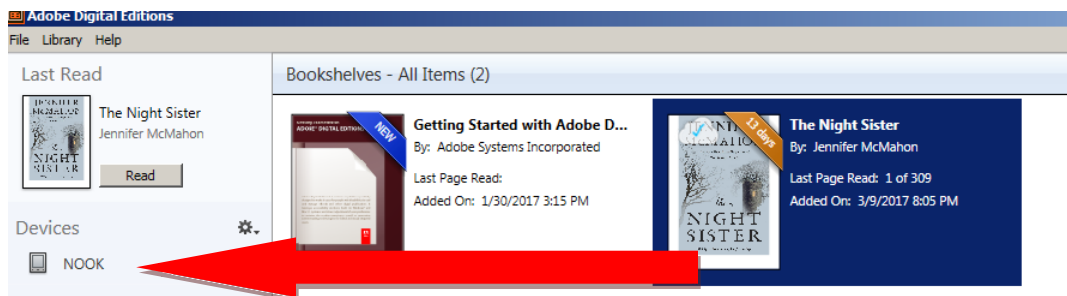
f. Go to your downloads (You may see the file on the bottom of your browser, or you may need to find your Downloads Folder on your computer)

g. Open the File and Adobe Digital Editions should open



h. Click on Library  at the top of Adobe Digital Editions page.

i. Click and drag the downloaded book to your Nook.



The book will transfer to your Nook and you can disconnect it from the computer and it will be ready for you to begin reading!
